## *Professional Safety* Book Review Guidelines

The following questions can be used to guide your review. Each question need not be answered or addressed formally but consider these areas in your overall evaluation. The review can be 250 to 800 words and should be submitted by e-mail (Word or PDF preferred) to [professionalsafety@assp.org](mailto:professionalsafety@assp.org).

- 1) Does this book adequately address the subject area for the intended audience in both scope and content?
- 2) Is it well organized?
- 3) Is the information clearly presented?
- 4) Are the practices and regulations (if applicable) cited current?
- 5) Are the practices and regulations (if applicable) cited the ones most often referenced by professionals working in this field?
- 6) What are the book's overall strengths? Weaknesses?
- 7) Is the intended audience (as indicated in the preface or cover blurb) likely to be the actual audience? If not, who is?
- 8) What makes this book unique?
- 9) Does the author provide examples, illustrations or similar aids that enhance the readers' comprehension?

Please provide the publication details for the book, including:

- complete book title;
- author name(s);
- year of publication;
- publisher name;
- ISBN if available.
