



## Procedures for Conference Session Sponsorship Safety 2021

Follow these instructions to submit an abbreviated version of your proposal to a practice specialty, common interest group, council or committee reviewer. This page includes instructions and the e-mail address to contact the appropriate groups(s) from which you are requesting sponsorship.

Please send an e-mail with the following information to the appropriate reviewer:

1. Session title
2. Description (100-word max description)
3. Bio (100-word max; be sure to highlight professional designations and work experiences that signify why you are an authority on the topic you would like to have sponsored)
4. A brief statement “Why do you think your topic is a good fit” to be sponsored by the select PS/CIG/Council/Committee.

You will receive a return e-mail confirming whether your topic was approved to be sponsored.

Your topic proposal and experience must be relevant to the mission and activities of the specific group(s) from which you are seeking sponsorship. Please note that sponsorships will be limited to a **total of two** sponsors.
