Council on Practices and Standards Awards & Honors Committee Committee Member Position Description

Purpose: The Council on Practices and Standards (CoPS) Awards & Honor Committee facilitates member recognition at the council, practice specialty and common interest group levels.

Key Responsibilities:

- Review nominations for Council Safety Professional of the Year Award
- Review practice specialty and common interest groups self-evaluation matrices
- Submit candidate(s) from the practice specialties or common interest groups for the ASSP Safety Professional of the Year Award
- Participate in committee conference calls about 1 hour each (July – December bi-monthly; January – March monthly)
- Assist with onsite duties during the Awards Luncheon at the PDC

Support:

- Orientation with CoPS Awards & Honors Committee Chair and staff liaison.

Benefits:

- Opportunity to recognize safety professionals for their commitment to ASSP and the profession
- Opportunity to contribute to the growth and development of ASSP and the safety profession
- Earn professional certification maintenance points

Time Commitment:

- Term of office: 3 years; July 1 – June 30
- Time commitment: 10-12 hours annually. Conference calls as noted above (7 hours annually); 3-4 hours in March during the evaluation process; 1 hour onsite at PDC in June.

Qualifications:

- Must be Professional Member, Member, or International Member of at least one of the practice specialties or common interest groups
