



Council on Academic Affairs and Research Council Member Position Description

Purpose: The Council on Academic Affairs and Research supports the future of the OSH profession and OSH professionals through the promotion and development of OSH higher education and research.

Key Responsibilities

- Make recommendations for academic-related Society goals, objectives and policy.
- Develop a strategy to engage OSH educators and college and university programs.
- Promote basic and applied research that advances the profession, including maintaining the ASSP research agenda and collaborating with the ASSP Foundation.
- Oversee the Educational Standards and Research Committees.
- Participate in meetings as needed, which will be held primarily via conference call.

Support

- Orientation with council vice president and staff liaison.

Benefits

- Opportunity to lend expertise to activities that have a lasting impact on the advancement of the profession and the Society.
- Earn professional certification maintenance points.

Time Commitment

- Term of office: 3 years; July 1 to June 30
- Average hours per month: up to 2 hours

Qualifications

- Member of ASSP in good standing
- Terminal degree (JD, PhD, MD, DSc, DPhil, etc.) and research experience preferred.
- At minimum two positions will be held for industry representatives.

Council members are appointed by the Vice President of the Council on Academic Affairs and Research and approved by the Board of Directors in June.
