Purpose: The Educational Standards Committee supports ASSP's ability to uphold and elevate the value of the safety and health profession by promoting the development and implementation of educational standards for post-secondary education.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the development and maintenance of ABET and model OSH learning outcomes for the associate's, bachelor's and master's degree levels.
- Promote academic quality, including ABET accreditation, to future students and existing programs.
- Serve as ABET program evaluator and/or mentor where applicable.
- Participate in in-person meetings and conference calls as needed.

Support

- Orientation with Educational Standards Committee chair and staff liaison.

Benefits

- Help shape and influence academic quality in occupational safety and health.
- Build knowledge of ABET program accreditation.
- Contribute to the growth and development of ASSP and the safety profession.
- Earn professional certification maintenance points.

Time Commitment

- Term of office: 3 years; July 1 to June 30
- Average hours per month: up to 5 hours

- Practicing academician, with two positions available for industry advisory representatives
