Committee Member Position Description

Purpose: The Outstanding Student Section of the Year Award (OSSA) Committee recognizes exceptional activities conducted by student members by assessing each student section's award submissions and helping select the winner for the OSSA.

Key Responsibilities

- Participate in 1 to 2 calls in April
- Contribute perspective and experience to the committee's work
- Help develop and improve the OSSA award process and program
- Assess and score submissions to make recommendations for the OSSA winner
