## Technical and Professional Recognition Committee Committee Member Position Description

**Purpose:** The Technical and Professional Recognition Committee advances the occupational safety and health profession through the recognition of model OSH professionals.

### Key Responsibilities

- Oversee the administration of Honor of Fellow, Society Safety Professional of the Year, Outstanding Safety Educator and other awards as developed
- Review and score petitions for each award Assist in the development of award criteria
- Participate in conference calls as needed and an annual meeting each January Make recommendations on award recipients to the Board of Directors

### Support

- Orientation with Technical and Professional Recognition Committee chair and staff liaison

### Benefits

- Influence the advancement of ASSP awards and recognition
- Contribute to the growth and development of ASSP and the safety profession
- Earn professional certification maintenance points

### Time Commitment

- Term of office: 3 years; July 1 to June 30
- Average hours per month: up to 10 hours, with most activity focused in October, November, January and February.

### Qualifications

- Member of ASSP in good standing
- At least three members of this committee must be ASSP Fellows
