Technical and Professional Recognition Committee Committee Member Position Description

Purpose: The Technical and Professional Recognition Committee advances the occupational safety and health profession through the recognition of model OSH professionals.

Key Responsibilities

- Oversee the administration of Honor of Fellow, Society Safety Professional of the Year, and other awards as developed.
- Evaluate all qualified petitions submitted for these honors.
- Make recommendation to the Board of Directors those professional members who qualify for the honor of Fellow.
- Make final determination on the society Safety Professional of the Year award and notify the Board of Directors.
- Assist in the development of award criteria.
- Participate in conference calls as needed and an annual meeting each January.

Support

- Orientation with Technical and Professional Recognition Committee chair and staff liaison

Benefits

- Influence the advancement of ASSP awards and recognition.
- Contribute to the growth and development of ASSP and the safety profession.
- Earn professional certification maintenance points.

Time Commitment

- Term of office: 3 years; July 1 to June 30.
- Average hours per month: up to 10 hours, with most activity focused in October, November, January and February.

Qualifications

- Member of ASSP in good standing.
- At least three members of this committee must be ASSP Fellows.

Contact

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The Technical and Professional Recognition Committee is a seven-member standing committee of ASSP. The president-elect appoints members and the chairperson for approval by the Board of Directors. Nominations are reviewed each May and appointments are announced each June.



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
