Rodd Wagner is a *New York Times* bestselling author and contributor to *Forbes*. His most recent book is *Widgets: The 12 New Rules for Managing Your Employees As If They're Real People*. Wagner and Dr. Gale Muller wrote the book *Power of 2* based on five years of research into the science of collaboration.

Wagner is one of the foremost authorities on collaboration and employee performance, and is currently completing his fourth book. His thought leadership focuses on how human nature affects business strategy.
