- You receive a free lunch at the convention center on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday! Your three lunch vouchers will be printed with your badge. Don't lose them because they can't be replaced. The vouchers can be redeemed in the lunch area of the expo hall.
- On that Tuesday, don't miss the 15-minute Tech Talk on the new ASSP Safety Trekr AI technology at 3:45 pm in Expo Booth 1061. It's a groundbreaking AI-powered search tool designed to accelerate and enhance the work of safety professionals, ultimately reducing the risk of on-the-job injuries, illnesses and fatalities.
